"Everyone Knows that..."

- * 'Central agencies' and 'international donors'
- Publish multiple & often conflicting definitions and advice about evaluation
- Without giving any explanation

Report to Donors from ECD meeting in SEA

"Assist [us] with designing M&E system that is...accepted by the government and by development partners"

Confirmed at week-long meeting of experienced gov't officials

Textbook – Glossary

meta-evaluation

a synthesis of existing program evaluation studies in a given area, designed to summarize current knowledge about a particular type of program.

Sage Publications (2006)

Same Textbook

meta-analysis

the same as meta-evaluation

Exploratory Research

- Was there one original definition of metaevaluation?
- Do other publications provide alternative definitions of meta-evaluation?
- Was the original definition of metaevaluation readily available in 2006?
- Did Sage ask any evaluation experts to review this textbook before publication?

Original definition of meta-evaluation?

- Michael Scriven led an Evaluation Workshop in Melbourne some years ago
- Michael described how he coined the term *meta*-evaluation

Michael Scriven's Story

- First degree in philosophy (University of Melbourne)
- Studied linguistics
- Meta-evaluation based on the term meta-language

Alternative definitions of meta-evaluation?

Meta-evaluation

- evaluations designed to aggregate findings from a series of evaluations.
- can also...denote the evaluation of an evaluation to judge its quality and/or assess the performance of the evaluators.

OECD (2002)

Was Scriven's Original Definition Readily Available in 2006 and earlier?

Meta-Evaluation is...
the evaluation of evaluations—
indirectly, the evaluation of evaluators

Effectiveness

- > OECD Glossary (2001)
 - The extent to which...objectives were
 achieved, or are expected to be achieved,
 taking into account their relative importance.
- Canada Treasury Board (2001)
 - The extent to which an organisation, policy, program or initiative is meeting its planned results.

Effectiveness


- ➤ INTOSAI Auditing Standards (1992)
 - The extent to which **objectives** are **achieved** and the relationship between the intended
 impact and the actual impact of an activity
- New Zealand SSC (2003)
 - The impact of the goods and services produced for the community on outcomes.

So what about 'unexpected consequences'?

- > Appropriateness
 - Meeting needs of target populations OR
 - Fits within government policy
- > Relevance
 - Meeting needs of target populations
- > With **effectiveness**
 - Achievement of predetermined objectives

- ➤ Program Logic & Linkages Model
 - -Africa
 - -South East Asia
