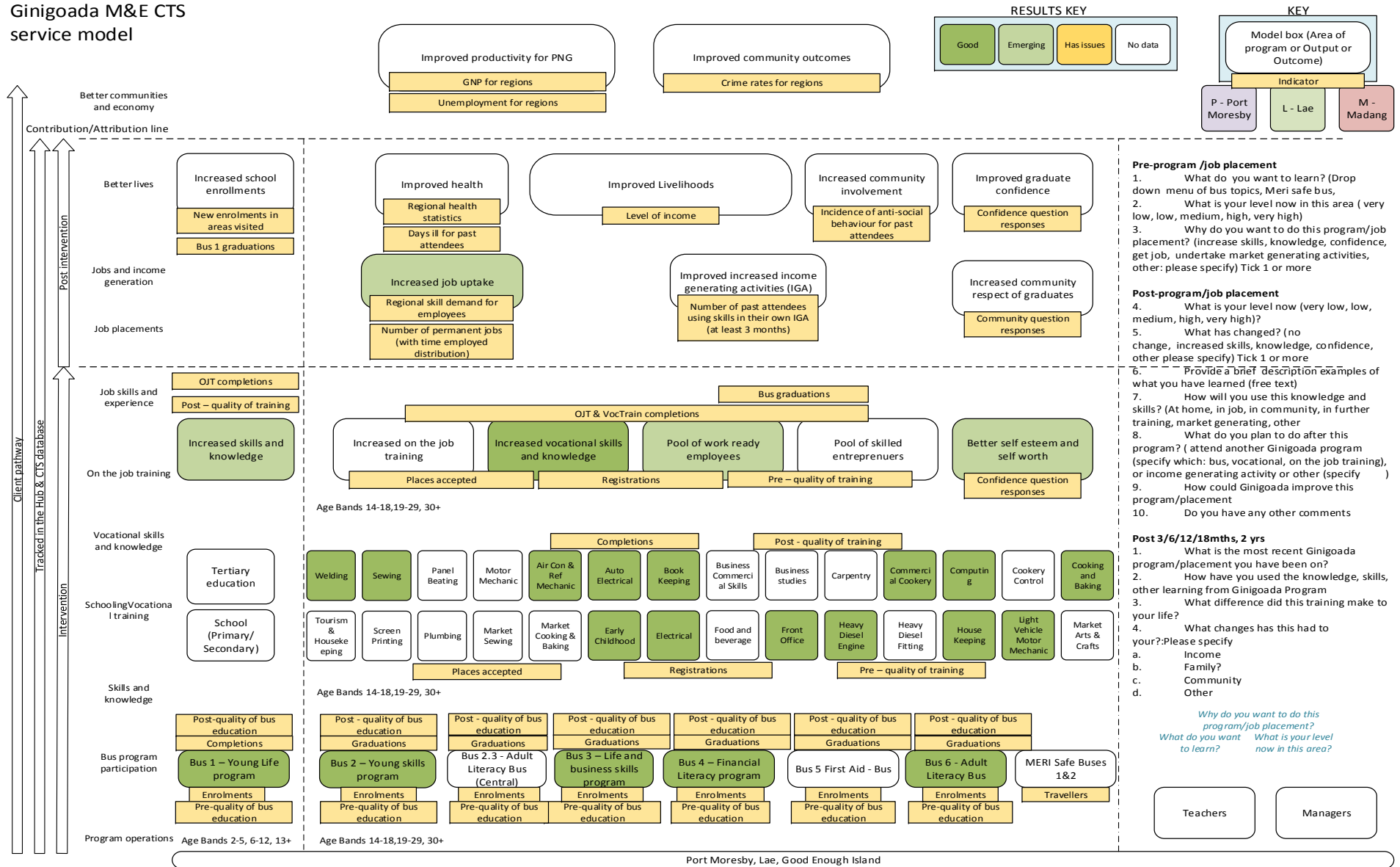

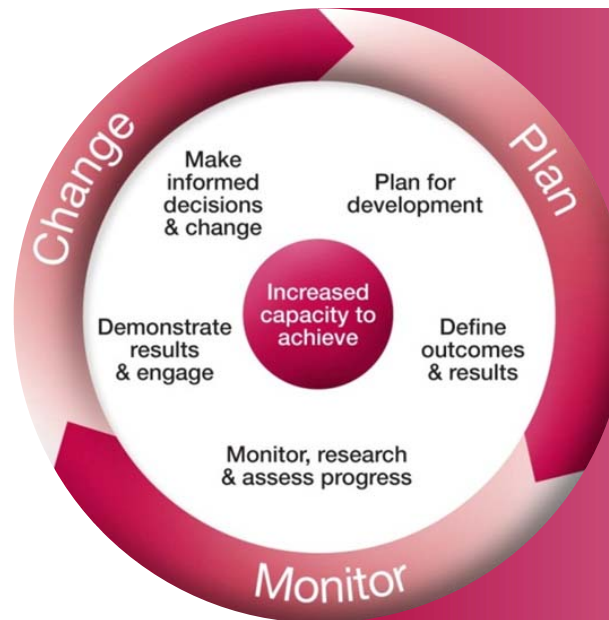
Ginigoada M&E CTS service model

Context




The term or phrase "Ginigoada" in the Motuan tongue translates to "Stand Strong" or to "Stand Strong Together".
