





We are a national First Nations Community Development and Research organisation.

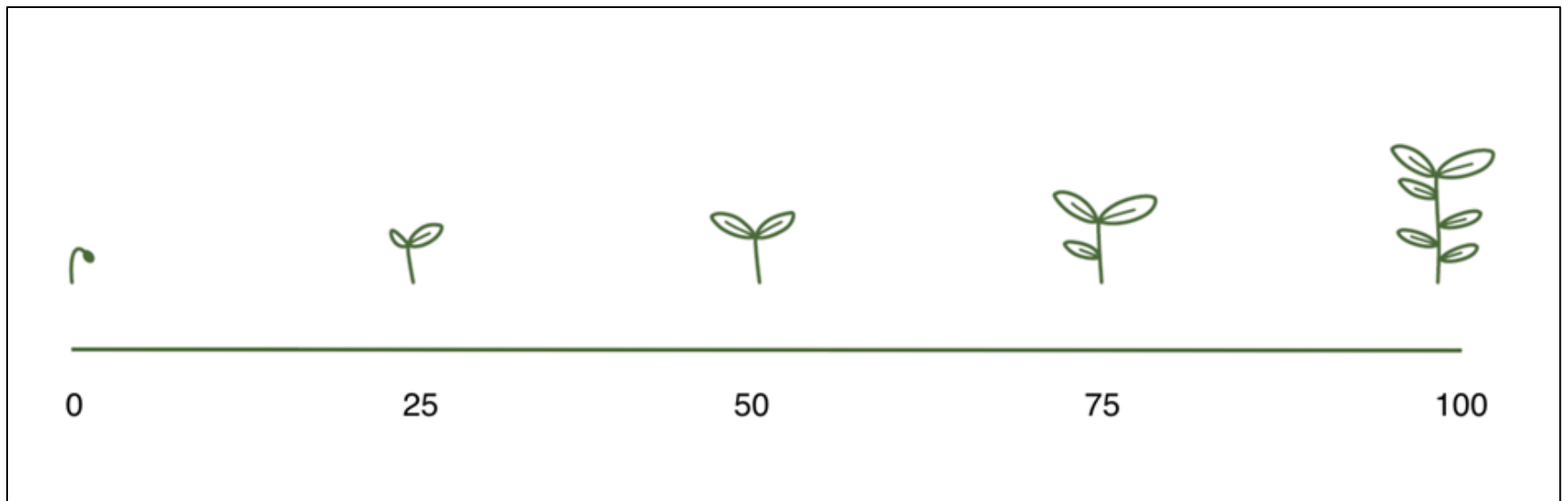

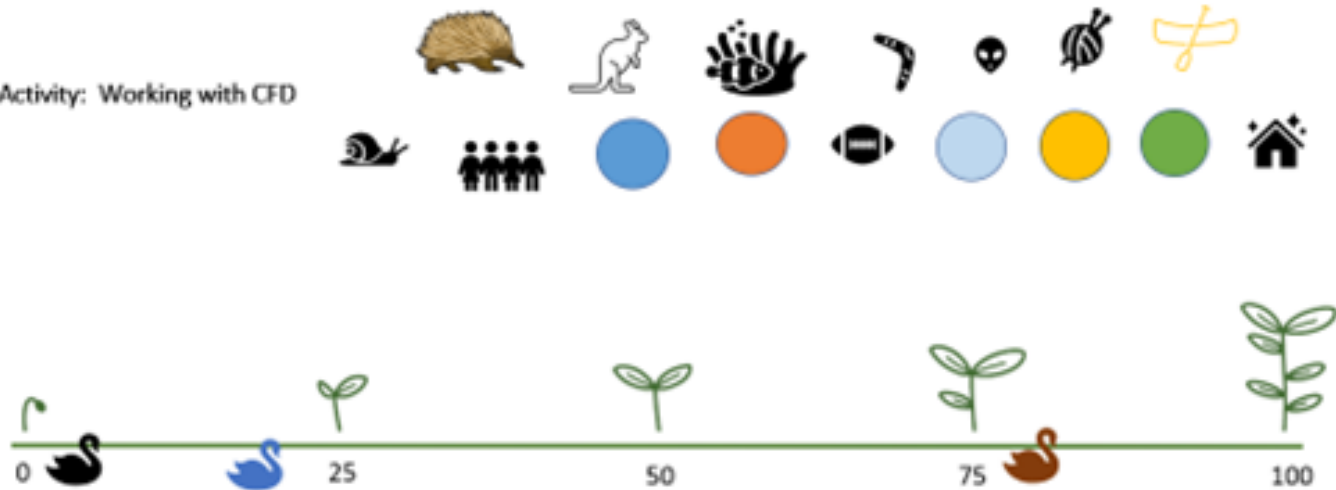
