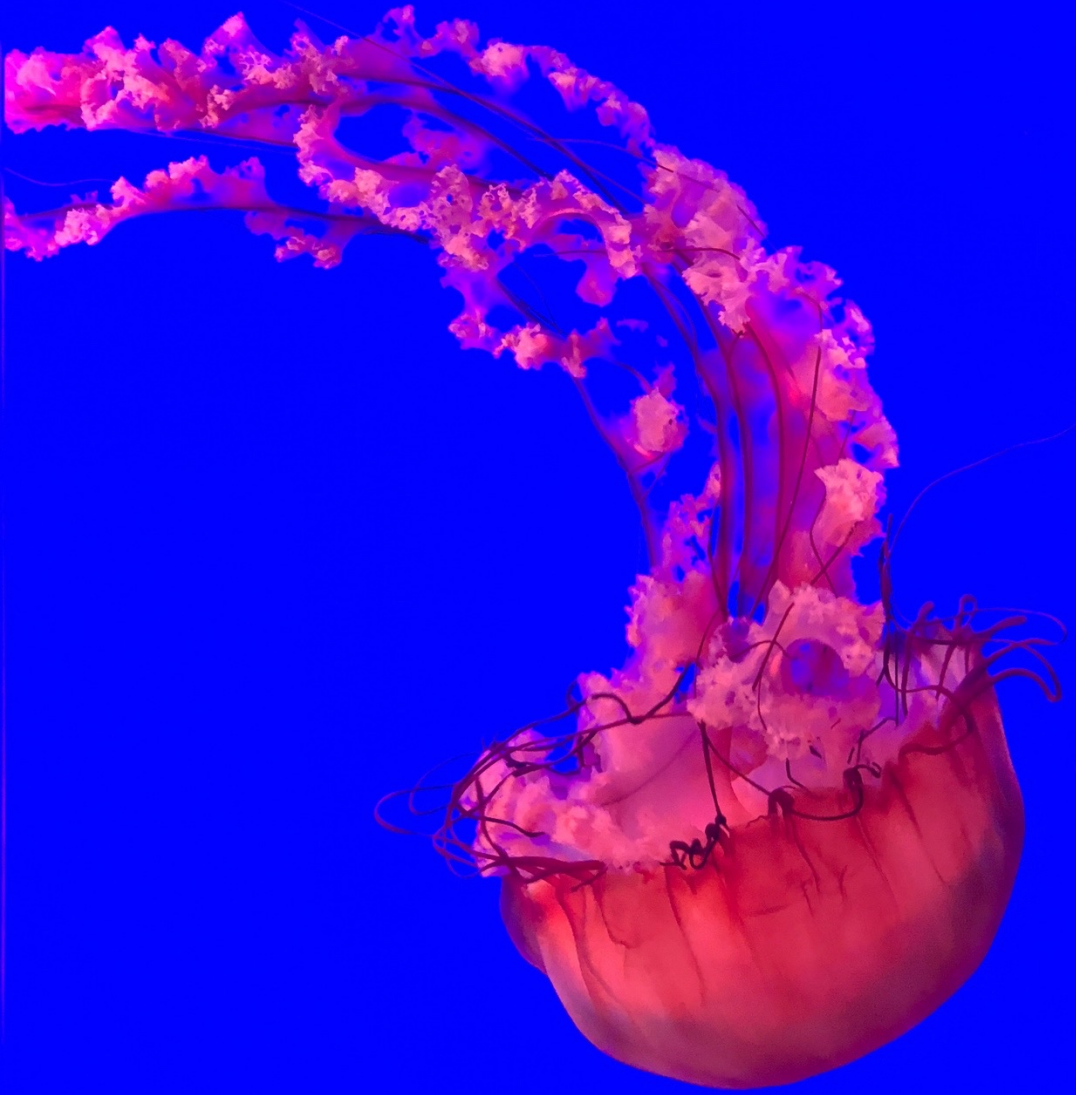

Reforms delivered

May 2023

- Funded Fair Work Commission's decision on the Aged Care Work Value case of a [15% increase to award wages for aged care workers](#) to take effect from 30 June 2023.

April 2023

- [Monthly Care Statements for residential aged care](#). Stage 2 of the pilot underway to improve the quality of information shared between a residential aged care home and its residents.
- New IT System, [Government Provider Management System \(GPMS\)](#) launched. Over time it will allow for greater connectivity and data sharing between aged care providers and government.
- [Six additional Aged Care Quality Indicators](#) for residential aged care providers were introduced. We have expanded the Quality Indicators (QI) Program to include 6 additional quality indicators.
- New [Council of Elders Chair](#) appointed.
