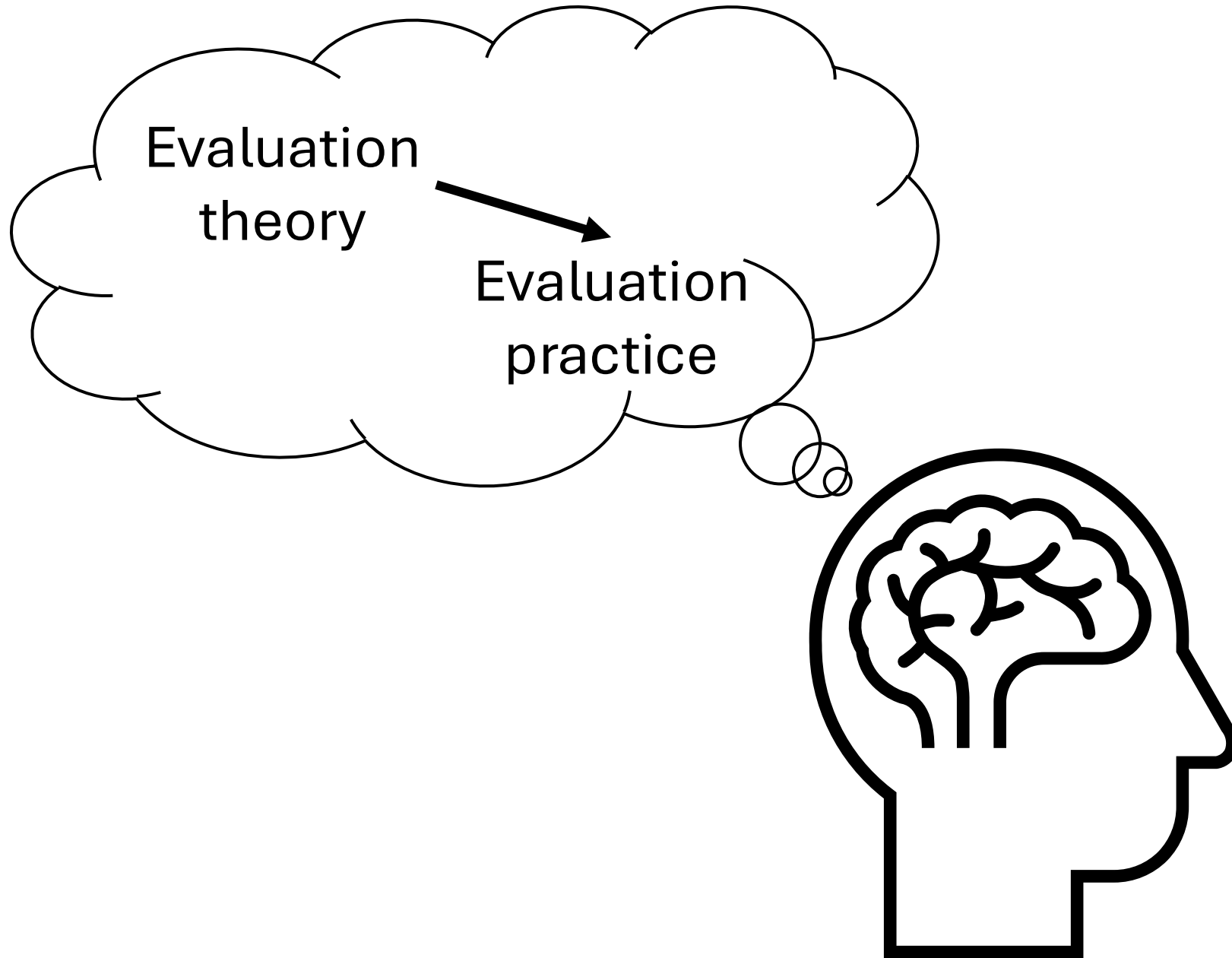

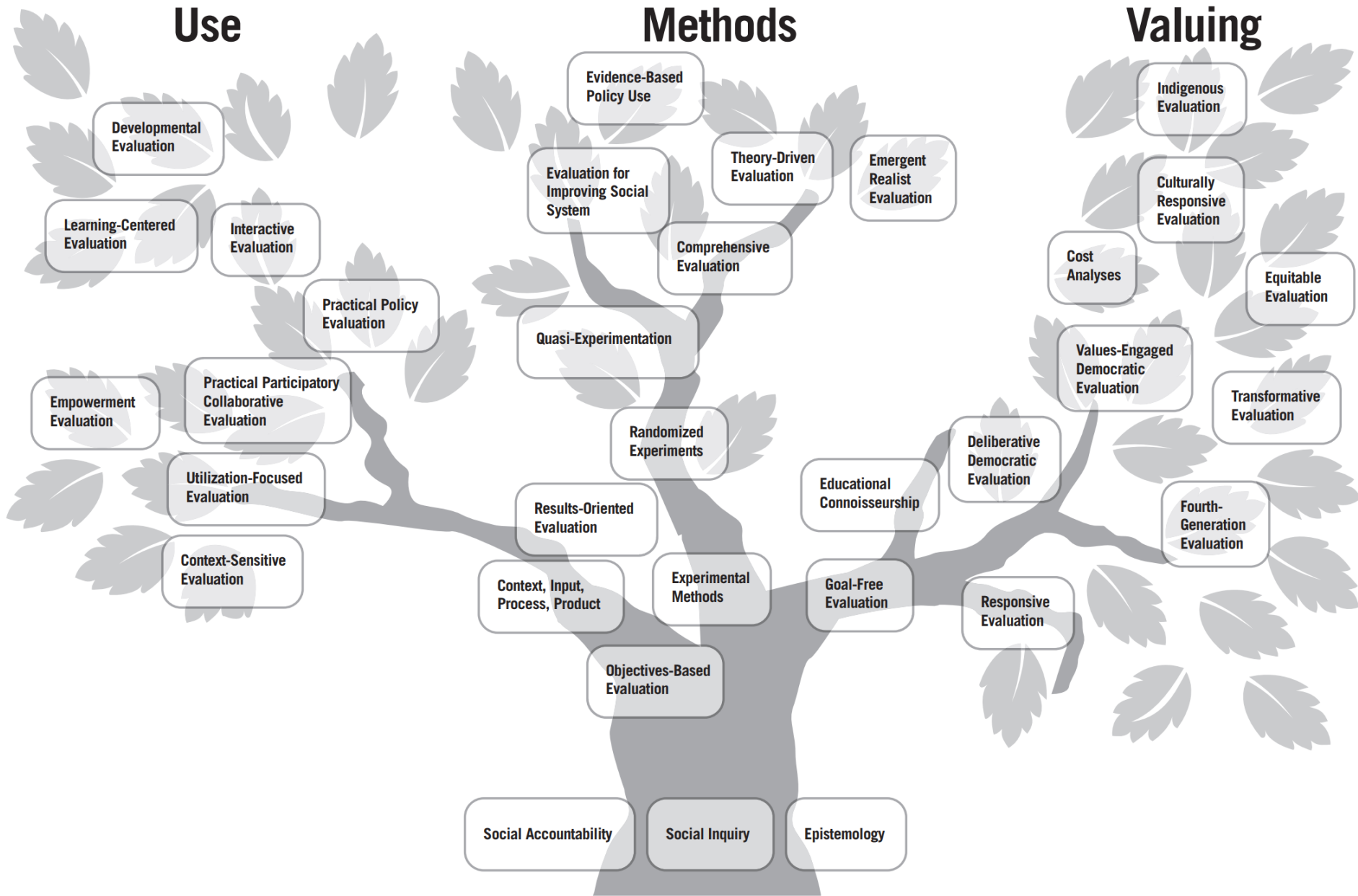


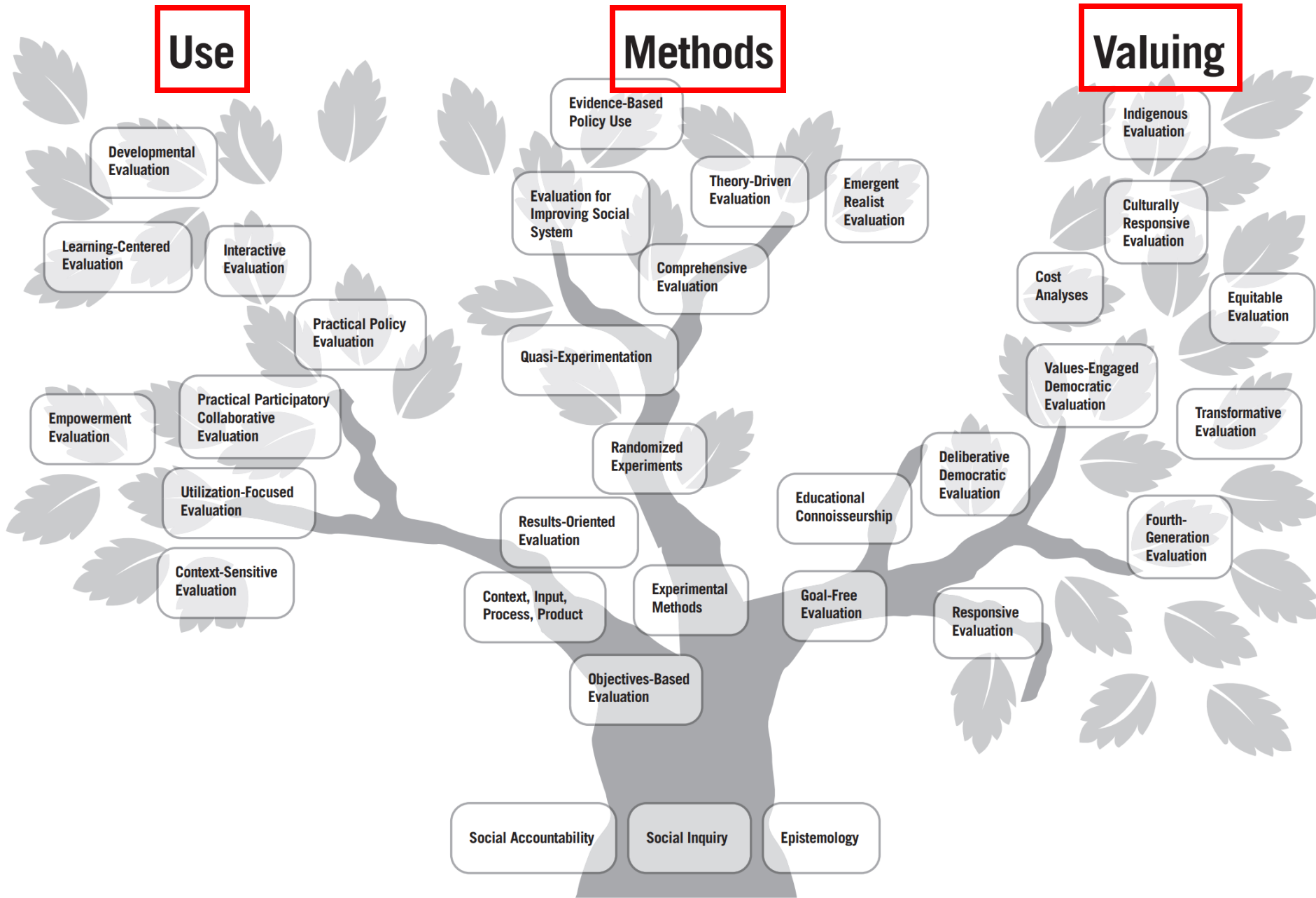

A set of guidelines of what a good evaluation is and how it should be conducted

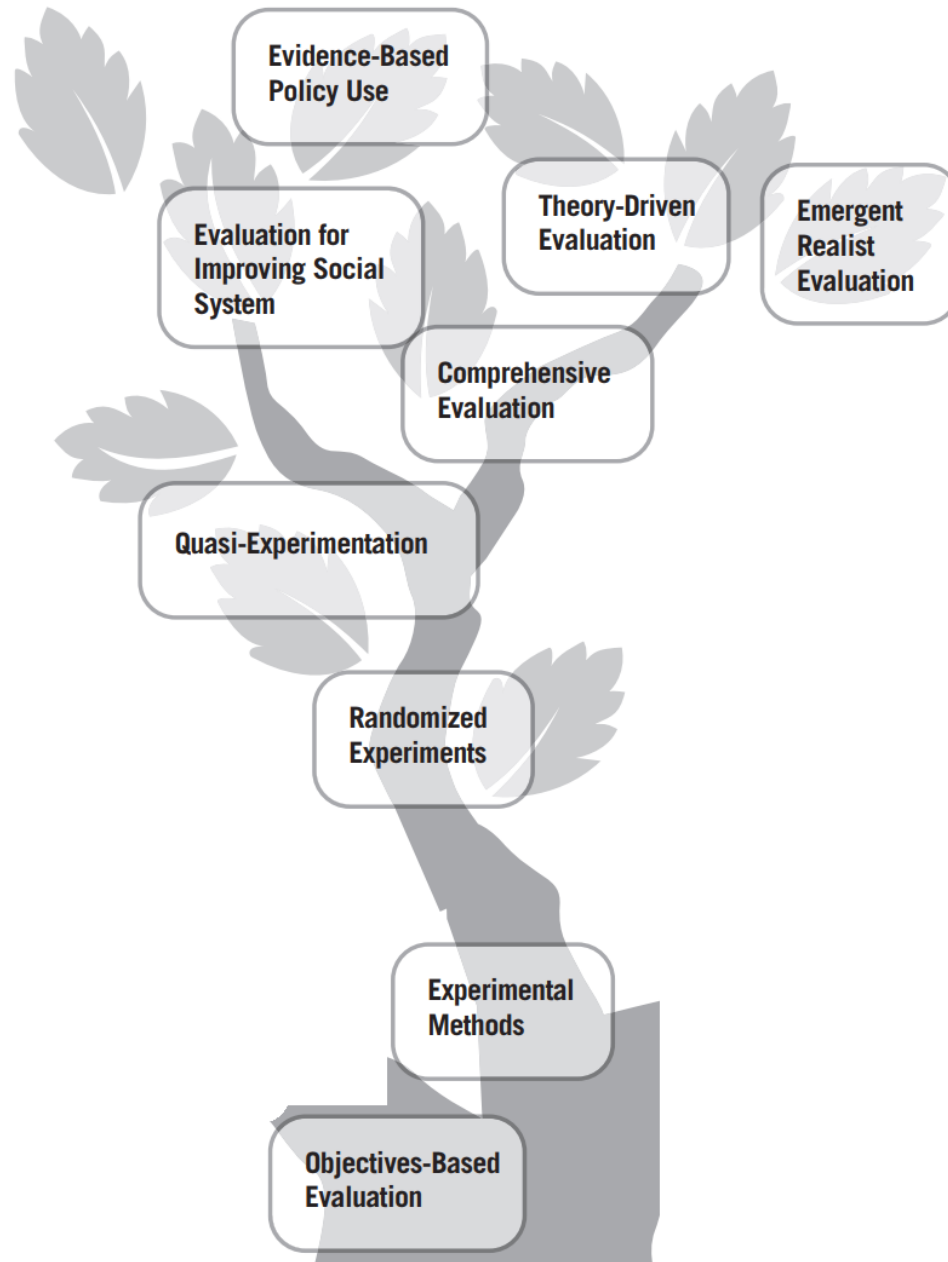
And if you do not know much about evaluation theory,

That **unique knowledge base** is evaluation theory...

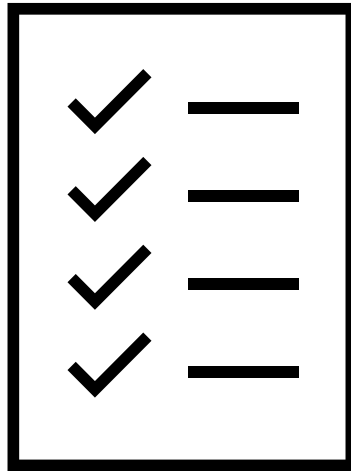
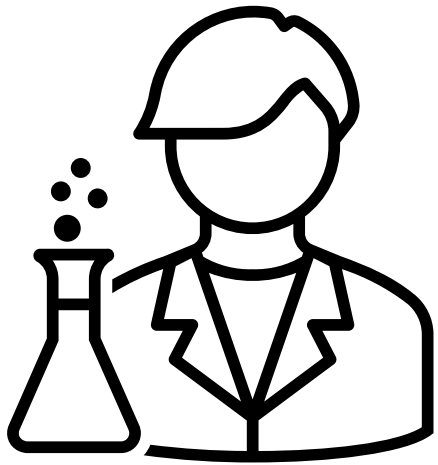
